



## CVO Jurisprudence Exam CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT – Test Taker

All candidates are specifically advised not to participate in any activity that could be construed as irregular behaviour. Irregular behaviour is conduct, in the College's opinion, which attempts to or is intended to assist any candidate to obtain a passing score by fraudulent means. Cheating during the test is considered irregular behaviour. Irregular behaviour would be subject to a report to the College for consideration of professional misconduct.

Failure to abide by the above advisement, may be sufficient cause for the Registrar to direct a penalty to terminate one's participation in the examination, invalidate the results of one's examination, withhold or revoke one's scores, bar one's participation in a future examination, or take other action as deemed appropriate by the College. This penalty may be appealed to the Registration Committee of the College of Veterinarians of Ontario.

Disclosure or dissemination of the College of Veterinarians of Ontario Jurisprudence Examination test items to any person is considered a breach in confidentiality and in security of the assessment items. All content of the test must remain confidential. Disclosure of the test items will also severely undermine the value of the test and adversely affect the validity of test results.

1. During the exam, I agree to not reference any source material outside the CVO Jurisprudence Examination Workbook; nor will I seek assistance from another person while sitting for the test.
2. I agree not to disclose or disseminate any information about test items before, during and after the exam. I understand making copies (paper, written and/or electronic) of the test items and/or notes of any content and/or a derivative of the items is strictly prohibited.
3. I understand any suspected activity of this nature will be reported to the College's Registrar and may be considered a breach of confidentiality and unprofessional and/or fraudulent behaviour.
