

## Food-Producing Animal Sample Drug Label Template

The following template has been developed as a resource for veterinarians that illustrates the requirements for a drug label. Members are encouraged to tailor it to their own needs.

When products are provided in original packaging that legibly includes some or all of the required information outlined in the template below, it is not necessary to repeat this information on the dispensing label.

If it is not feasible to include all of the information on the label due to the size of the packaging, it must be included on a separate sheet or via a weblink.

When the product is a compounded drug, the word “compounded” must be marked on the dispensing label.
